Domestic Violence is a serious violation of human rights.

In Japan, domestic violence (DV) is defined as violence suffered by a spouse or an equivalent person. Violence include not only physical violence, such as punching or kicking but also psychological violence, such as threatening, not providing living expenses, or sexual violence.

Japan has laws to protect domestic violence victims, also apply to all foreign residents of Japan, regardless of nationality or residence status, enable them to use various services. Please don't take it all on yourself, feel free to get in touch with us.

What happens to the residence status if an individual gets divorced or separated?

- The residence status will not be revoked if there are legitimate reasons caused by domestic violence, even if the individual fail to engage in activities as a spouse of a Japanese national or permanent resident for more than 6 months or failing to notify the place of residence.
